

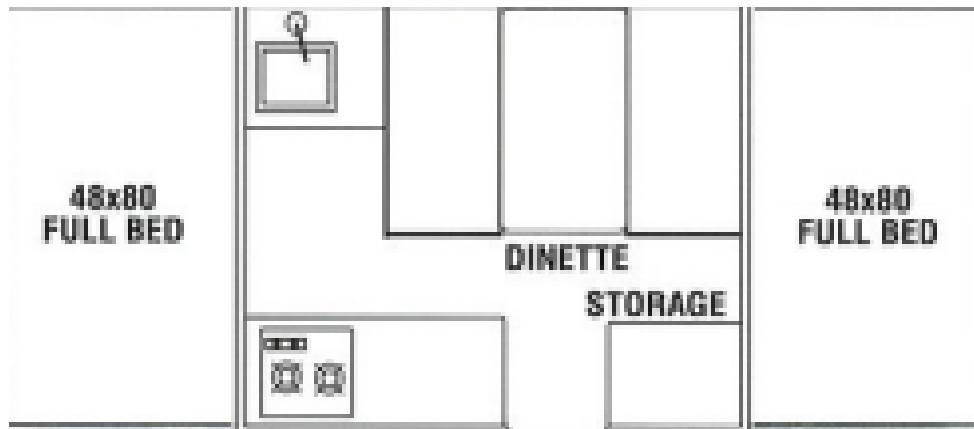

KOA Hurricane, Utah

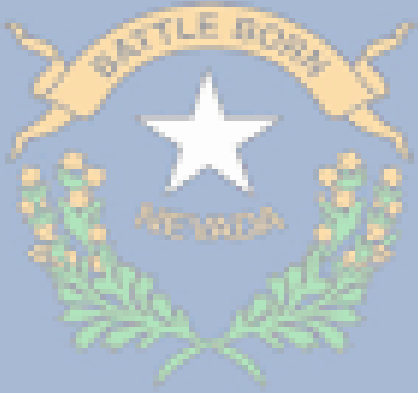

Terry Bison Ranch, Wyoming

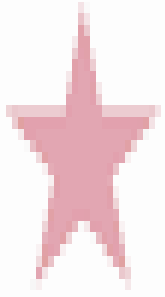

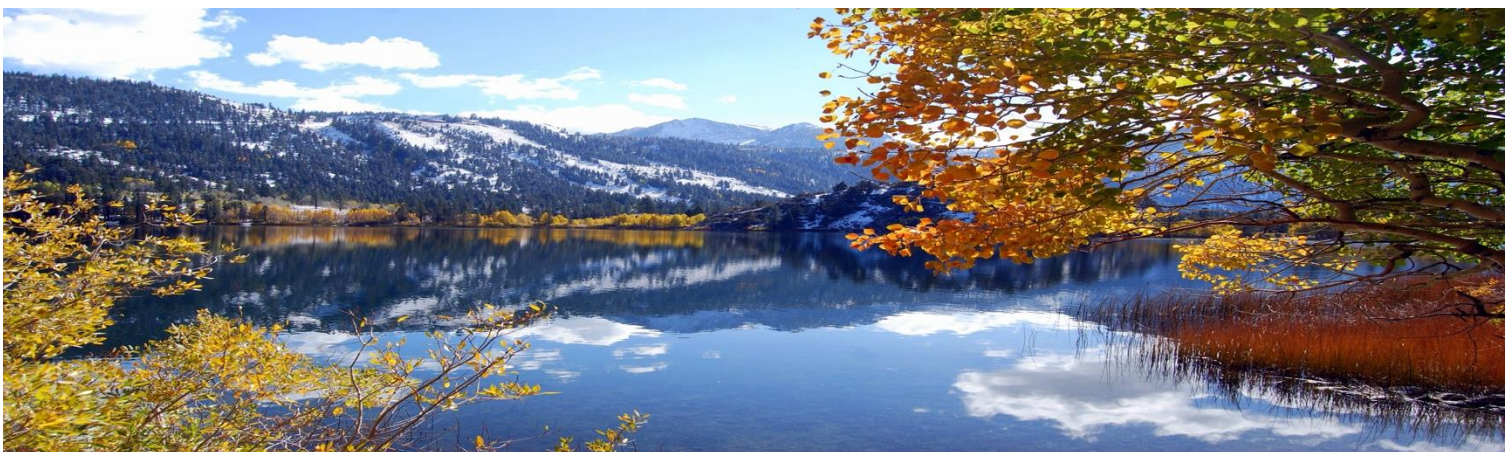
California Campgrounds

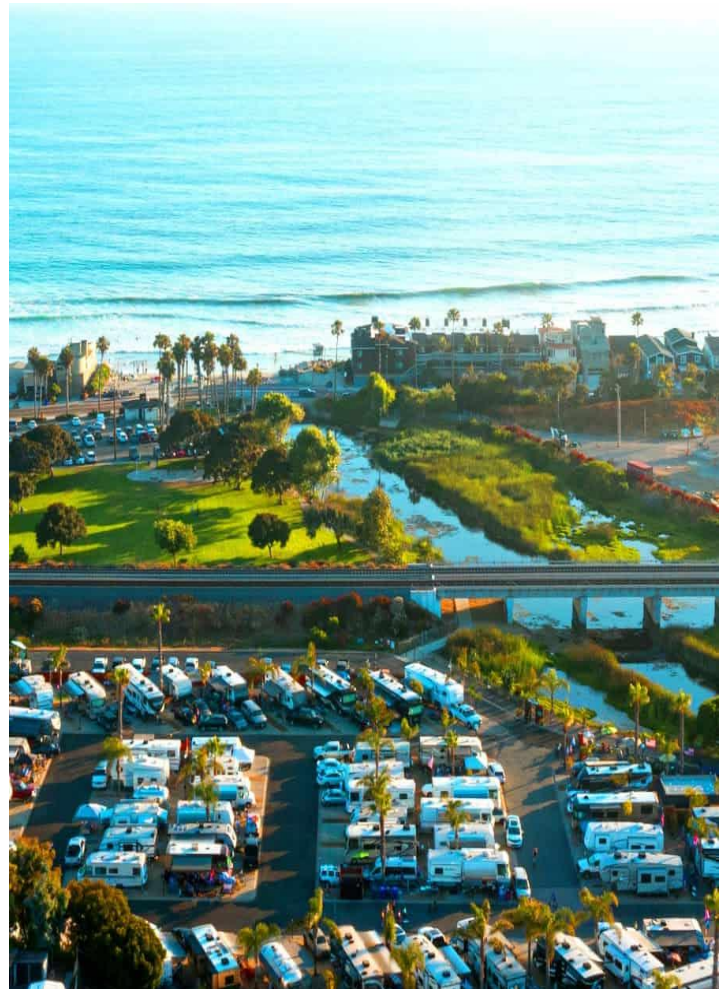
Thousand Trails, Palm Springs
